Russell James Lowe Jr. (RJ), 53, of Salisbury, passed away peacefully on Thursday, April 20, 2017, at the Glenn A. Kiser Hospice House from cancer surrounded by members of his family.

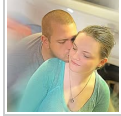
