



## Ruth Walters Campbell

May 30, 1919 - November 8, 2010

Mrs. Ruth Walters Campbell died Monday, November 8, 2010, just as she has lived, quietly and without fanfare and surrounded by family at the N.C. Lutheran Home at Trinity Oaks.

Born on May 30, 1919, Ruth was the daughter of the late Dr. and Mrs. C.M. Walters, Sr. of Burlington, NC. She graduated from Burlington High School in 1936 and attended Elon College.

Ruth was an active member of First Baptist Church of Salisbury, the Dorcas Sunday school class, Margaret White Circle and the Gold and Silver Senior Organization. She was a former member of the Milford Hills Lioness Club. Ruth was instrumental in the beginnings of the Good Shepherd Clinic at First Baptist Church.

In addition to her parents, Ruth was preceded in death by her husband, Cleveland "Cleve" Eugene Campbell, Sr. whom she married in 1938; daughter, Ruth Kathryn "Kay" Crouse, four sisters, and one brother.
