October 14, 1934 - December 13, 2009

Mrs. Sally Ann Bullock Bullock, 75, died Sunday, December 13, 2009 at Wake Forest University Baptist Medical Center in Winston-Salem.

She was born on October 14, 1934 in Granville County and was the daughter of the late John Watkins Bullock and Susan Pittard Bullock. She was a member of First Presbyterian Church of Salisbury.

A graduate of Peace College in Raleigh, Queens University in Charlotte, and Presbyterian School of Christian Education in Richmond, VA, she served as Director of Christian Education at the First Presbyterian Church in Concord, NC from 1958-1959; was a Missionary of the Presbyterian Church, US from 1963 to 1967 and a substitute teacher at West Rowan High School from 1983-1991.

Survivors include her husband, the Rev. Malcolm McLeod Bullock, whom she married on December 29, 1959; daughters, Harriett Phillips and husband Todd, of Concord, and Susan Brittan and husband Michael of Cary; sons, John Bullock and wife Patty, of High Point, James Bullock and wife Carrie of Winston Salem, and Stephen Bullock and wife Andrea of Salisbury; grandchildren, McLeod and Jack Phillips, Emily and Jonathan Brittan, Phillip, Andrew, Thomas, Paul Anna Blair, Katie, and Laura Bullock; sister, Sue Bullock Huggins, of Bullock, NC, and niece, Ann Cobb Huggins, of Oxford,

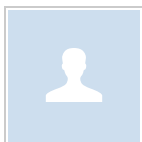
