



## Samuel C. Peacock, Jr.

October 25, 1915 - October 7, 2009

Mr. Samuel Clark Peacock, Jr., 93, of Chattanooga, TN passed away Wednesday, October 7, 2009 at Kindred Hospital in Chattanooga.

Born October 25, 1915 in Rowan County he was the son of the late Margaret Mae Bailey Peacock and Samuel C. Peacock. Mr. Peacock was educated at Boyden High School and attended Duke University and graduated from Catawba College and received two masters' degrees from California State University.

After college, Mr. Peacock served in the US Air Corp. Early in his career he worked as radio announcer and later a proof reader for the Charlotte Observer. He also worked in both Alaska and Hawaii before settling in San Francisco in the mid-1940's. He taught school in a specialized medical clerical field program in California. Four years ago he moved to Chattanooga to be closer to family. H. Elizabeth Peacock and Lynn Peacock Spaw were nieces and residents of Tennessee.

Mr. Peacock is preceded in death by his three sisters, Helen, Ruth, and Margaret and brother, Walt. He is survived by his brother, Charles Peacock of Salisbury, NC.
