



Samuel Alexander Moir Jr.

September 13, 1924 - October 20, 2018

Samuel Alexander Moir, Jr., 94, of Salisbury died October 20, 2018 at NC State Veterans Home.

He was born September 13, 1924 in Stokes County, the son of Samuel A. Moir, Sr. and Isabelle Jessup Moir. Sam fought in World War II from 1942-1944, serving as a machine gunner and navigator on B29 bombers in the Pacific. After the war he attended Appalachian State and while in Boone met and married Betty Ruth Winkler, who preceded him in death after 55 years of marriage.

Sam played minor league baseball for several seasons before embarking upon a career in coaching basketball. After an undefeated state championship year at Mt. Airy High School, he came to Catawba College in 1960 and coached basketball there for over 30 years. He was an inductee of numerous halls of fame including the Catawba College Hall of Fame, Rowan County Hall of Fame, North Carolina Hall of Fame, NAIA Hall of Fame, Mt Airy Hall of Fame, Surry County Hall of Fame, and as well as the Appalachian State University Distinguished Alumni Award. He was proud of his players and especially their successes after graduation. He always looked forward to seeing and hearing from them.

Sam is survived by his son David Michael Moir, his son Dr. Ronald Jeffrey Moir and daughter-in-law Lisa Smith Moir, grandchildren: Joshua Franklin Mooring, Andrew Jordan Moir, Samantha Moir Belk, and Jacob Brandon Moir. He is also survived by 5 great-grandchildren, his beloved brother, Charles

Robert Moir and honorary family member Susan Smith.

A Service of Celebration will be held Saturday, October 27, 2018 at Omwake-Dearborn Chapel at Catawba College at 3:00 PM with Dr. Rev. Kenneth Lance officiating. A private burial will follow the service with military rites conducted.
