



Mrs. Sarah Louise Glenn Waddell

August 2, 1928 - July 30, 2021

Sarah Louise Glenn Waddell, 92, of Salisbury, passed away Friday, July 30, 2021 at Novant Health Rowan Medical Center.

Born August 2, 1928 in Belmont, she was the daughter of the late Pearl Caldwell Glenn and John Lester Glenn.

She was educated in the China Grove schools, graduated from China Grove High School, Wingate College and was a member of the first graduating class of Cabarrus School of Nursing in 1951. She was a former Miss China Grove.

Mrs. Waddell was a Registered Nurse and was employed at Cabarrus Memorial Hospital, Presbyterian Hospital, Rowan Memorial Hospital, served as a Rowan County Health Department Nurse and a school nurse before retiring in 1990.

She was a member of Milford Hills Baptist Church, Women's Missionary Union (WMU) and taught and served in various capacities.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband Ralph Devon Waddell on August 17, 1996; sister, Mary Beaver; brothers, Johnny Glenn and Billy Glenn.
