She stayed very active with her church, volunteer work, friends, family and especially her 5 grandchildren. Sharon was diagnosed with Multiple Sclerosis in 1975 and spent the majority of her adult life fighting hard for her health. She worked out daily and for many years would spend several hours each week swimming laps at the YMCA. Her determination and strong will were an inspiration to many as she showed others that even with a handicap, you can live a full and

happy life.
