After World War II Stefania and her husband moved to New York City where they lived and raised their family. She moved to Salisbury in 2003 with her daughter and has lived there with her family ever since.

She was a loving woman who endured many hardships and faced them all with strength & resolve. She was deeply loved by her family and will be greatly missed. May she find everlasting joy and happiness, now being reunited with her husband Stanislaw and her son Andrew in Heaven.
