Susan Peurifoy Queen, 75, of Salisbury, died, Monday May 19th, at the Kate B Reynolds Hospice House in Winston-Salem.

She was born on September 16, 1949, in High Point, the daughter of the late Ruby Ritter Peurifoy and Woodrow Peurifoy. Susan graduated from High Point Central High School and High Point College. She attended the First United Methodist Church of Salisbury and worked as a technical writer for Duke Energy for 22 years before taking early retirement. She worked an additional 20 years for Signature Consultants, providing technical writing services for Wachovia, Bank of America, Spectrum, and Areva.
