Sylvia "Candy" Taylor Snider, 89, of Salisbury, NC passed away February 21, 2026 at the North Carolina State Veterans Home in Salisbury, NC.

She was born August 12, 1936 to Anderson Kistler and Grace Rivers Taylor. Mrs. Snider graduated from Landis High School. Early in her career she was employed by the Federal Reserve Bank in Charlotte, NC.
