Temperance Louise Hudson Parnell, 88, of the Dukeville Community died Saturday, November 26, 2011 at Rowan Regional Medical Center.

Born July 27, 1923 in Salisbury, she was the daughter of the late Joseph Washington and Nora Etta Hall Hudson. She was educated in the Granite Quarry schools and graduated from Granite Quarry High School, Class of 1941 and Salisbury Business College.
