Terrie Lee Sherrill Vail, 66, of Salisbury, passed away on Thursday, July 29, 2021, at the Novant Health Glenn A. Kiser Hospice House with her family by her side.

Terrie was born May 13, 1955, in Dodge County, GA to Lenora Hambrick Sherrill and the late Allen Merrick Sherrill. She graduated from R.B. Stall High School in Charleston, SC in 1973 and received an Associates Degree from Wingate College in 1975. Terrie worked for the Charleston News & Courier for 5 years and then with the Charleston Naval Weapons Station before getting married and moving to Salisbury in 1981. She worked at Catawba College for a year prior to working as a secretary with NC Department Juvenile Justice in Rowan County until her retirement after 30 years of service in 2013.

Terrie was a devoted member of Stallings Memorial Baptist Church, singing in the choir and as a soloist. She taught a ladies Sunday School class for several years and was active in the Women's mission group. She had a heart for missions and went on mission trips to Romania, Trinidad, NC coast and West Virginia.
