



Terry Gorman Fries

July 31, 1936 - September 20, 2025

Terry Gorman Fries, 89, of Salisbury, passed away on Saturday, September 20, 2025, at his residence. He was born on July 31, 1936, in Rowan County, the son of the late Rudyard Kipling Fries and the late Agnes Marie Whitley Fries.

Terry was the owner/operator of Fries Color TV Service and was the Director of Ellis Park until his retirement. He was a lifelong member of Mt. Tabor United Methodist Church and a member of The Gideons International. He was instrumental in acquiring the Ellis School Property to become Ellis Park. He was also involved in starting the coach pitch little league baseball at the park. Mr. Fries was an outstanding baseball player in his own right, he played on the Spencer High School and Spencer American Legion Teams. He played in the Yadkin Valley and Stan Musial baseball leagues. He also played Industrial League and church softball.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his son Chris Fries. Those left to cherish his memory are his wife of 70 years, Sheila Cain Fries, son Todd Fries of Gold Hill, daughter, Robin F. Taylor (Keith) of Salisbury, daughter-in-law, Kelli Fries of Salisbury, grandchildren, Seth Taylor (Kelly), Hillarie Fries, Tyson Fries (Nicole), Rachel Smith (Patrick), Colton Fries (Miranda), Corey Fries (Courtney), and Eight great-grandchildren
