Doctor Theodore (Ted) Benjamin Bowen of Salisbury passed peacefully March 31st at the age of 70. Born April 16th 1952, Ted followed his parents footsteps into a lifelong career in education. He attended Elon University and Appalachian State for his master's program. He received his Doctorate of Education from Gardner Webb. He was a teacher, assistant principal, principal and later traveled throughout North Carolina as an evaluator for the NC Department of Education before teaching graduate level courses at Gardner Webb. He ended his career in an independent education consulting role.

Ted was a private person and often worked behind the scenes and did much to help and support children, the elderly and local volunteer firefighters.

Ted loved the beach and the mountains and traveled frequently to both locations. He was an accomplished musician and woodworker completing his log home among other projects. He was pursuing beekeeping, glass blowing, stained glass and other projects.
