



Thermon "Terry" L. Gibbons, Jr.

October 28, 1945 - February 10, 2010

Mr. Thermon L. "Terry" Gibbons, Jr, 64, of Salisbury, NC passed away on Wednesday, February 10, 2010 at his residence.

Born October 28, 1945 in Columbia, SC Terry Gibbons was the son of Mary Grace Dozier Gibbons of Charlotte and the late Thermon L. Gibbons, Sr.

Terry loved reading and playing golf and was a loyal Clemson Tigers fan. He enjoyed travel and always cherished the time he spent with family and friends while living and working in Queretaro, Mexico. He was devoted to his family and was a constant source of help and encouragement to those he loved.

Whether it was just a call to say hello or a flight halfway across the country, he was always there to lend his support. He was very proud to have become a grandfather for the first time in October of 2009.

He was a graduate of Garinger High School in Charlotte and received his B.S. from Clemson University. He served in the US Army. Mr. Gibbons was employed at PPG from 1970-1978, Fiber Industries/ Hoechst-Celanese from 1978-2001, Western Nonwovens from 2001-2008, and was most recently self employed. He is a member of First Presbyterian Church, Salisbury.

He is survived by his wife, Edna Austin Gibbons, who he married in 1971; son David Gibbons of Boulder, CO; daughters Amy G. Frost and husband Robert of Charlotte, NC and Julie Gibbons of New York, NY; brothers, David A.

Gibbons and wife Debbie of Raleigh, NC and Tom Gibbons of Coral Springs, FL; sister, Anne G. Ray and husband Terry of Knoxville, TN; and grandson, Austin Frost.

Visitation will be held Saturday, February 13, 2010 from 10:00 AM – 12:00 PM at Summersett Funeral Home at 1315 West Innes Street in Salisbury. 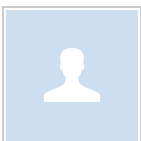
