Thomas Lee Overcash, 82, of Salisbury, NC passed away Wednesday, October 8, 2025 at Autumn Care of Salisbury.

Mr. Overcash attended Boyden High School and Stauton Military Academy. He graduated from Catawba College with a bachelor's degree in business.
