Trenton Edward Smith, 60, passed away on Monday, March 20, 2017 in an automobile accident in Iredell County, miles from his Rowan County home. Born in Salisbury, NC he was the son of the late Joseph Hurley Smith Sr. and Mary Gheen Smith whom survived his death.

Mr. Smith graduated from East Rowan High School in 1974 and attended cabinet making classes at Rowan Cabarrus Community College. He was an active member at Cornerstone Baptist Church in Cleveland where he served on many mission trips serving and building churches in Montana, New York, Alaska, Colorado, and Wyoming. He began employment part-time at DuraFiber Technologies (then known as Fiber Industries) his junior year of high school in 1973 and worked there ever since. On his days off he did odd jobs and home improvement projects, some for pay and other for volunteer. He donated over 60 gallons of blood to the Red Cross and donated several feet of his hair to Locks of Love. He was a faithful Dallas Cowboys fan.

Those left to cherish his memory are his wife of 19 years, Deana Fisher Smith of Cleveland; son, Eddie Smith (Martha Marie) of Salisbury; mother, Mary Gheen Smith of Salisbury; brothers, Joe Smith (Patricia) of Salisbury and Victor Smith of Salisbury; grandchildren, Selah, Brayden, Kara Joy, and Noah of Salisbury; parrot, Prettyboy who was born in 1960.

The family will receive friends Saturday, March 25 at 1:00PM and following the 2:00PM Memorial Service at Trinity Wesleyan Church with Rev. Eddie Smith, Rev. Mack Jarvis, and Rev. Michael Rakes officiating.

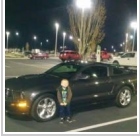
