Mrs. Vickie B. Lynch, 61, passed away November 22, 2012 at her home after a gallant 10 year fight with lymphoma.

Mrs. Lynch was born October 3, 1951 in Washington, DC as the eldest daughter of Victor O. Baird and Barbara Mitchell Baird. She was educated in Maryland schools and was employed in the Office of Superintendent United States Senate in Washington, DC.

While living in Illinois, Vickie was employed by Archer Daniels Midland Company (ADM) in various positions from Internal Audit to computer technology. During this time she was involved in community activity serving as the loan ADM executive to the United Way. She relocated to Salisbury in 1994, with her husband's transfer, and founded Specialized Computer Support and was active in numerous community activities including the United Way, Chamber of Commerce and Rowan Rotary where she was a Paul Harris Fellow.

She is survived by her husband of 42 years, Tom Lynch, who she married June 20, 1970. Vickie is the loving mother of three surviving children, Christina Lynch of Salisbury, Thomas Lynch Jr. (Kim) of Indian Trail, NC , and Benjamin Lynch (Teal) of Salisbury; and grandchildren, Alyssa and Parker Lang, Hayden, Reagan, and Sumter Lynch.
