January 20, 1916 - January 16, 2016

Victor Wilson Reid, 99, of Salisbury, NC, died Saturday, January 16, 2016, peacefully at the NC State Veterans' Home.

Born on January 20, 1916 in Caldwell County at the home of the late Samuel Lee Reid and Ovella Hester Reid.

He served in the U. S. Army from 1940-1945, with the 1st Battalion, 158th Regimental Combat Team while deployed in the Panama Canal Zone, New Guinea, Noemfoor Island and the Philippines, and was awarded the Bronze Star for "Gallantry in Action."

Victor was also longtime resident of Ramseur, NC and Greensboro, NC.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by son Milton Carl Grose and wife Susan Allred Grose; brothers Howard Reid, Chancey "Bub" Reid and wife Mary, William "Bill" Reid, Steele Reid, and sister Sue Reid Land and husband Woodrow.
