Virginia Lee Fetterman Krotchko, 88, of Salisbury, passed away December 18, 2024 at her residence.

Born August 12, 1936 in Mt. Carmel, PA, she was the daughter of the late Arnold Fetterman and Edith Adam Fetterman. She graduated from Mount Carmel High School in 1954 and was employed by Bell Telephone as a switchboard operator through the early 1960s. Virginia became a homemaker after the birth of her first son, Mark.

She was a member of First United Methodist Church where she sang in the Chancel and Celebration choirs and was a member of the United Methodist Women, serving as their President for a period. She was a past member of the Rowan Choral Society and enjoyed singing and was an avid gardener. Virginia also was an active volunteer, performing music programs at the VA Hospital, Rowan Helping Ministries, Meals on Wheels, and enjoyed serving with Rotary Club of Salisbury, among others.
