



## Vivian McCall Boyd

August 26, 1920 - June 19, 2011

Mrs. Vivian McCall Boyd passed away on June 19, 2011 after a week long illness. She was born on August 26, 1920 in Clio, SC to the late James Lonnie McCall and Alma Lillian Davis McCall Jarrell.

Mrs. Boyd graduated from Lingle Elementary School (a 2 room schoolhouse) and was valedictorian of her graduating class at Mt. Ulla High School in 1937. She received her BA Degree in 1941 and her Master's Degree in Education in 1963 from UNCG. Mrs. Boyd taught business education for 40 ½ years in North Carolina. The last 23 years she taught at East Rowan High School before retiring in 1982.

Mrs. Boyd was a member of Second Presbyterian Church from 1950 until 2000 where she served as an Elder, a Sunday school Teacher, and a member of Circle #2. She has been a member of Neel Road Baptist Church from 2000 until the present time. Mrs. Boyd previously held membership in Delta Phi Epsilon, a graduate business fraternity, and Gamma Theta Chapter of Alpha Delta Kappa, a teacher's honorary sorority.

Mrs. Boyd is preceded in death by her husband F.J. Boyd and two brothers. She is survived by one daughter, Anne Boyd Kimball, who is married to H. Thomas Kimball Jr., 2 special granddaughters, Elizabeth Standafer who is married to Greg Standafer, Karen Spurrier, 7 special great grandchildren,

Kelsey Spurrier, Keirsten Spurrier, Robert Spurrier, Jacob Standafer, Leah Andrews, Logan Andrews, and Jenna Standafer, and nieces and nephews.

A memorial service will be held on Thursday (June 23) at 2:00 PM in the Summersett Memorial Chapel. Visitation will be immediately following the service. Private burial will follow at Rowan Memorial Park.
