Walter Glenn “Jack” Stuard, II, 77 of Salisbury died Friday, June 11, 2010 at Presbyterian Hospital, Charlotte, NC

Born October 24, 1932 in Adams, TN, he was the son of the late Ida Bell Young Stuard and Walter Glenn Stuard, Sr. He was educated in the Cedar Hill and Adams, TN schools and graduated from Joe Burns High School. He attended the Nazarene College in Nashville, TN and received his LPN training at Rowan Cabarrus Community College.

Mr. Stuard was a veteran of the US Army during the Korean War and served in the National Guard for 20 years.
