Warren D. Ashe, Jr., 64, of Salisbury passed away Wednesday, February 12, 2020 at his home.

Born January 23, 1956 in Skowhegan, Maine, he was the son of the late Lowney York Ashe and Warren D. Ashe, Sr.

He was educated in the Skowhegan schools and was a veteran of the US Army during the Vietnam War.

An avid outdoorsman, he loved wood working and enjoyed riding his motorcycle and was known all over as "Bear". He was a member of many motorcycle clubs including Extorris Motorcycle Club.
