Warren Charles Detgen, 86, of Salisbury passed away Saturday, July 20, 2013 at the Glenn Kiser Hospice House.

Born July 3, 1927 in Cleveland, OH, he was the son of the late Gertrude Iseler Detgen and Walter Detgen.

He was educated in the Port Hope, MI schools and was a veteran of the US Army, serving in General MacArthur,s Headquarters in Tokyo at the end of World War II.

Mr. Detgen was employed by the City of Detroit Police Department and retired as a Sergeant and later was employed by the South Lyon School System as a Maintenance Supervisor.
