Warren G. Morgan passed away peacefully on February 25, 2026 at home in loving care of his family.

Born October 5, 1927 in Rowan County, he was the son of Samuel J. and Nettie Yates Morgan. He was a graduate of Granite Quarry High School class of 1944. Shortly after graduation he joined the United States Navy and served aboard the U S S Dyess DD 880 in the Atlantic and Pacific Theatres sailing into Japan shortly after the Japanese surrendered. After discharge he worked for Norfolk Southern Railway in the repair shop in Spencer, N.C. and later in the freight yard as a car inspector for 43 years before retiring. He also worked as a substitute mail carrier for several years. He was a member of Trinity Wesleyan Church and served as Sunday School Superintendent for a number of years.

Warren was preceded in death by his wife, Evelyn C. Morgan, his parents, one brother, J C Morgan, two sisters, Leona Hayworth, and Annie Laurie Harrison and a dear granddaughter, Mary Ellen Morgan.

He is survived by two sons, Gary Morgan and wife Betty of Troutman, and Tim Morgan and wife Karen of Charlotte. He is also survived by three granddaughters, April Rollins, Julie Bell and Mary Katherine Quattlebaum (Trey); two grandsons, Tyler Morgan (Stephanie) and John Morgan; five great-grandsons, Hunter Rollins, Sawyer Rollins, Luke Morgan, Will Quattlebaum and Matthew Quattlebaum; four great-granddaughters, Charlotte Bell, Katelyn Morgan, Morgan Quattlebaum, and Savannah Rollins.
