Wilhelmina "Billie" Silva Mobley, 77, of Winston-Salem, NC passed away Friday, August 23, 2024.

Mrs. Mobley was born November 23, 1946, in Newark, NJ to the late Armando Joseph Silva and Della Sizemore Silva. She pursued her education at Campbell College before founding her own company, Carolina Advertising, working with corporations and business owners for over 50 years.

Mrs. Mobley spent decades dedicating herself in service to her Catholic faith. As the beloved president and foundress of the Te Deum Foundation, Mrs. Mobley tirelessly supported and fostered vocations to the Roman Catholic Priesthood by providing for the material and spiritual needs of seminarians and also ensuring that more than 150 seminarians from 25 dioceses received scholarships for the annual Fatima Peace Pilgrimage and overseeing the purchase and development of land in preparation for a major seminary in the Southeast.

She was honored by being invested as a Dame of the Equestrian Order of the Holy Sepulcher of Jerusalem, a pontifical chivalric order which seeks to preserve the Christian presence in the Holy Land, attaining the rank of Dame Commander with Star.

Left to cherish her memory is her husband of 57 years, Leonard Mobley; daughter, Cheryl Mobley Vogler (Mark) of Lewisville, NC; brother, Andy Silva (Donna) of Durham, NC; sister, Miriam Atria (Nick) of Columbia, SC; grandchildren: Brandon Vogler (Ashley) and Andrew Vogler (Kayla Schmitz)

great-grandchildren: Luke Vogler and Brady Vogler. She also leaves several special nephews that were so fondly thought of and a big part of her life. Mrs. Mobley's family will receive friends from 5-7 PM Sunday (Sept 1) at Sacred Heart Catholic Church in Salisbury, NC. 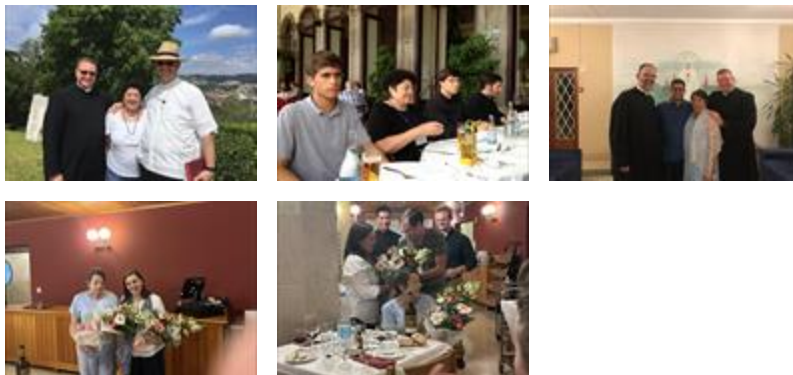
