



William "Bill" Lloyd Gullett

July 7, 1934 - June 1, 2024

William Lloyd "Bill" Gullett, Jr., 89, of Salisbury, passed away on Saturday June 1, 2024, at Novant Health/Glenn A. Kiser Hospice House.

He was born on July 7, 1934, the son of the late William Lloyd Gullett, Sr. and the late Ossie Lucille Bailey Gullett in Jerusalem Township, Davie County, North Carolina. He was a veteran of the United States Army, serving as a Combat Engineer. Bill retired from Duke Power Company after 30 years of service as a manager and as a consultant. After retiring, he worked for E. H. Wright as a General Manager.

He attended Peninsula Baptist Church for 18 years where he was Sunday School Director and served on many church committees. Bill and Faye also served at the Mooresville Soup Kitchen for the church. When they decided to downsize from their house on Lake Norman, they moved back to Salisbury where they attended First Baptist Church of Salisbury. Faye and Bill were heavily involved in the First Baptist Church's "Meals on Wheels" program. He was past member of the Institute of Electrical and Electronics Engineers, American Association of Instrumentation as well as other associations. He was a member of the Lake Norman Lions Club. Bill was also an advisor for Catawba Technical College and Rowan Cabarrus Community College for Computer Aided Design.

Those left to cherish his memory are his wife of 67 years Faye Howell Gullett, three children, William Douglas Gullett (wife Rhonda), Brian Lee Gullett (wife Jennifer) and Susan Gullett Walters (husband Louis). Grandchildren Nick Gullett, Steven Gullett, Tommy Walters and nephews Patrick Gullett and Scott Gullett as well as numerous nieces and nephews in the Bailey family.

The family will receive friends on Thursday, June 6, 2024, from 12:00PM until 1:00PM at First Baptist Church of Salisbury. A Memorial Service will follow at 1:00PM with the Rev. Bryan Blackwell officiating. Entombment will follow in the Rowan Memorial Park Chapel in the Pines Mausoleum.
