



## William "Bill" L. Kesler

July 11, 1940 - April 23, 2025

William "Bill" L. Kesler, 84, of Salisbury, NC passed away Wednesday, April 23, 2025 at Novant Health Rowan Medical Center.

Bill was born July 11, 1940 in Rowan County, NC to the late Ethel Taylor Kesler and Lavern Baline "Bill" Kesler. He was a graduate of Boyden High School Class of 1958 where he played baseball and helped lead the team to win the State Championship his Senior year. Bill played for the Rowan County American Legion Baseball team. He was awarded a scholarship for baseball at Pfeiffer College. Later he enjoyed playing fast pitch softball for many years. Bill was a veteran of the U.S. Army serving in the 82nd Airborne as a Paratrooper from 1959-1961. He worked as a traffic manager for Norandal until his retirement, being recognized as having perfect attendance and never being late for over 40 years. Bill loved fishing and hunting and spending time with his family. Everyone loved Bill, whether they were friends or family, he was a giver to all.

Bill was a member of John Calvin Presbyterian Church. He volunteered for Rowan Helping Ministries for many years.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Carolyn Burns Kesler.

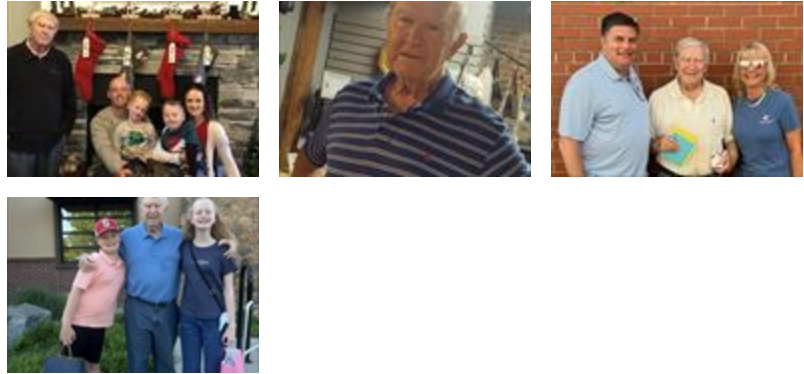
