William "Bill" David Simon, 75, of Norwood, NC passed away Tuesday, December 3, 2024 after a hard fought battle with acute myeloid leukemia (AML).

Bill was born March 2, 1949 in Massillon, Ohio to the late Dorothy Rogers Simon and Robert Simon. He attended Kent State and was a veteran of the U.S. Army. Bill worked for Tyson Roller Bearings while living in Ohio, and Preformed Line Products in Albemarle, NC.

At home he could be found with a cup of coffee in hand, sitting by the window to watch his cats. Bill could also be found at flea markets or junking with his best friend and brother-in-law, Terry. He cherished his family and was incredibly proud of his children and grandchildren.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his sister, Virginia Simon.

Left to cherish his memory is his wife of 33 years, Susan Buehner Simon; son, William David Simon, Jr (Jennifer) of Columbus, OH; daughter, Samantha Simon (Matthew Cuddington) of Raleigh, NC; sisters, Jeanne Harsh (Terry) of Cornelia, GA and Kathy Criss (David) of Georgia; grandchildren: William Simon and Owen Simon, and several nieces and nephews.
