April 23, 1925 - January 25, 2015

William Summerell Hall, Sr., 89, of Mt. Ulla, died at Autumn Care of Statesville on January 25, 2015.

Bill was born April 23, 1925, to Carl W. Hall and Ruth Caldwell Hall in Rowan County. He served as a paratrooper in the Army's 82nd Airborne Division during WWII. He graduated from North Carolina State University, and then returned to the family dairy farm. Bill was a life-long member of Thyatira Presbyterian Church where he was an Elder Emeritus.

He was preceded in death by his wife of 55 years Kathryn Griffin Hall, a brother Carl Wells Hall, Jr.; and three sisters, Sarah Hall Jordan, Ruth Hall Rendleman and Phoebe Hall Beard.

Bill is survived by two children, Bill Jr. (Cam) of Mt. Ulla, and Trina Hall Jackson (Craig) of Advance, NC, two granddaughters, Kathryn Jackson Maltarich (Mike) and Sarah Jackson McNeill (Dan), three great-grandchildren, Jack Maltarich, Matthew Maltarich and Paige McNeill, all of Charlotte.
