December 10, 1918 - January 30, 2012

Mr. William Robert Voss, 93, of Salisbury, NC passed away January 30, 2012 at the W. G. Hefner VA Medical Center.

He was born December 10, 1918 in New York, NY to the late Elizabeth Stang Voss and William R. Voss. He was a graduate of Fort Lee High School in Fort Lee, NJ. Mr. Voss served in the U.S. Army Air Corp from 1941-1945. He was a decorated WWII POW and was retired from the Air Force Reserve as a Major. For 35 years he was employed by Southern Bell Telephone Co.

Mr. Voss was a member of First Baptist Church and was a longtime resident of Salisbury.

He was preceded in death by his wife, Louise Ramsey Voss on November 19, 1996. Three brothers, Arthur, Charles and George Voss and a sister Anna Voss Earle also preceded him in death. Several nieces and nephews and a brother in law, Donald Earle survive him.

A graveside service will be held at 11:00 AM Thursday (Feb 2) at City Memorial Park.
