Wilson Krider Fleming, 69 of Salisbury died on Monday, November 15, 2010 at Liberty Commons Nursing and Rehabilitation Center in Salisbury after three years and three months of illness.

Born January 5, 1941 in Rowan County, NC to the late Albert Henderson Fleming and Eva Nell Shook Fleming, he was a graduate of Woodleaf High School, Columbia Bible College, Covenant Theological Seminary in St. Louis, MO, He taught for 19 years in Christian Schools.
