Mr. Winfred Bare, 91, of Salisbury, NC passed away Thursday, August 27, 2009 at his residence.

Born December 10, 1917 in Wilkes County, NC to the late Polly Ellen Dixon Bare and Lee Bare, he was educated in the Ashe County Schools. Mr. Bare was a home builder, a carpenter, and established both Bare Furniture Company in China Grove and Anne Roland Furniture Company in Salisbury. He attended Franklin Baptist Church.

Mr. Bare was preceded in death by his wife of 60 years, Lillian Rebecca Shepherd Bare on September 29, 1999.
