



Zula Bowers Earnhardt

April 1, 1916 - September 14, 2009

Zula Bowers Earnhardt, 93, died Monday, Sept. 14, 2009 at Montgomery General Hospital in Olney, MD after a long illness.

Born April 1, 1916 in Albemarle, she was the daughter of the late James Bowers and Eva Fesperman Bowers. Mrs. Earnhardt was educated in the Rowan County school system and graduated from Boyden High School.

Mrs. Earnhardt worked at Cones Mill as a weaver for over 40 years. She was a life long member of St. John's Lutheran Church where she taught religious education.

In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband Ray Earnhardt on January 8, 2000 and by three sisters, Wilma Rudicil, Ruth Brown, and Christine Clark.
